

Kayaking on the Llano River at Robinson Park and Badu Park is a popular pastime in Llano. Robinson Park offers a small boat ramp for easy launching and a recently added fishing pier that is handicap accessible. Kayak rentals are available in many locations, in town and along the river. Robinson Park is known for some of the best bass fishing on the Llano River. There is also an RV Park with full hookups just off the river and tent camping is available throughout the park.

Badu Park offers a sand beach for recreation and swimming along the banks of the river and an all new zero-depth Splash Pad. Both parks have walking trails around them, playgrounds for children, pavilions and clean rest rooms. Grenwelge Park, next to the Llano Library and Red Top Jail is ideal for family picnics, Trout Fishing in the cooler months and Rock Stacking year round.

Llano was founded in 1855 on the banks of the clear, spring-fed Llano River, and became the county seat in 1856. It was well established by 1860 with stores, saloons, and a hotel, yet there was no church in the rough frontier village. Llano was the last train stop for settlers heading west. Settlers going beyond Llano in wagons or on horseback faced hostile Indian territory and the rough West Texas terrain

Llano is rich with history of Indian conflicts, raids, and famous outlaws. Old railroad hotels dotted the border of the railyard and one of those, the Dabbs Railroad Hotel, is still in operation today.

The entire downtown has been designated a National Historic District, and a comprehensive walking tour is a must for the short or long term visitor. Included are sites that are a must visit for anyone spending time in Llano, the Red Top Jail, the LanTex Theater, the Llano County Historical Museum, the Railyard District, the recently restored Llano County Courthouse, the Roy Inks Bridge and the beautiful city parks that wind along the banks of the pristine Llano River.






Llano Earth Art Fest





Llano County "Red Top" Jail

The oldest B & B in Llano would definitely be the Llano County "Red Top" Jail which served the community from 1895 to 1982. A landmark and historical site today, the Red Top Jail housed jailors and their families on the first floor, prisoners on the second and third floors, and a gallows on the fourth floor. The Red Top Jail is a Romanesque

Llano County Courthouse

Llano's current courthouse located in the center of Llano's historic square was originally built in 1893. It is still used to hold district court today. The building is essentially the same as when it was constructed, and is the 39th oldest



in the state. Monuments
that surround this city
sentinel are dedicated
to veterans of the
Confederacy, World War
I, and Vietnam. The
Llano County Courthouse
and its grounds are used
today as the station
for daily government
workers as well as many
celebrations and events



Lantex Theater

The Lantex Theater was built in 1927. It is run by the City of Llano Main Street program. which shows current movies on weekends. The second Saturday of every month is the Llano Country Opry. The Lantex now boasts a new digital projector and sound system, bringing the vintage movie house to a state-of-the-art level. A year-long restoration project to return the art deco-era theater to its former sparkle has culminated in new seating in the auditorium and balcony. Highlights of the project

include all new LED lighting throughout the theater, refinished floors and aisle carpeting, restored lobby, stage, surround sound and ADA seating areas. Soon a new ADA ramp and sidewalks will connect the rear exits with Berry and Main Streets.

Llano County Historical Museum

Located on the banks of the Llano River, the Llano County Historical Museum is housed in the historic Bruhl Building. The old drug store's original soda fountain is still in place and complements the museum's displays of artifacts collected from residents and



families of the area that tell the story of the development of Llano County. From geologic samples to frontier firearms, from polo equipment to military uniforms, there is something of interest for everyone. The museum hosts special exhibits and is constantly updating its collection. It is also home to Western Trappings on the Llano, a juried exhibit and sale of quality western art and custom gear, held in October. The museum is open Wednesday through Saturday, 11:00 am – 5:00pm and at other times by arrangement.
